Breakfast Club: Just a reminder to parents and carers that our Breakfast Club is open from 8.10am every day, for the amazing cost of only 30p per child. Having spoken to many Headteacher's of lots of schools, our Breakfast Club offers the best value for money anywhere in the County. The children are offered a wide selection of healthy breakfast choices and then are supervised on the yard or to do indoor activities with staff. PLEASE NOTE: children must not arrive on site before 8.10am coming to Breakfast Club.

Internet & Permission Forms: The office staff are updating all pupil and contact information and is vital that all forms are returned by Tuesday next week, please. If you specifically **do not** give permission for photographs to be taken (as they may be uploaded onto our school TV channel, which is now streamed to the school website), you must let the office know ASAP.

Uniforms It is wonderful to see everyone in school uniform this year: the children look smart and show that they belong to our WCPS family. Please remember this extends to PE kit which can be ordered from the school office. All children must also wear PE shoes or trainers for PE lessons. Can I also ask that EVERY item of school uniform is named over the weekend: already, we have had some brand new jumpers lost and without names, it is very difficult to find their owners. Our fantastic new lockers are helping keep the children's belongings safe and tidy but we still need to label them please!

Dinners: School dinners are charged at £1.95 a day, (£9.75 per week). Dinner money must be paid on a Monday morning. If you believe you are eligible for Free School Meals, please speak to Mrs Dixon, who will let you know what paperwork you need to provide to school. Non-payment of dinner money will mean parents / carers may have to provide a packed lunch and all overdue payments are referred to the Local Authority Debt Recovery team.



Bottles are available for £1.50 from the office, or you can provide your own. As a reminder, those children who bring a packed lunch are not permitted to bring fizzy drinks to school. Thank you.
