

<u>School Council Meeting</u> <u>Wednesday 4th November – Action points</u>

- Children in Need is Friday November 13th. We agreed to come to school dressed as Superheroes, and to make a donation to Children in Need. (If you don't have a Superhero outfit, Pudsey t-shirts or yellow t-shirts are fine.) Pudsey wristbands will be available in the school office on Monday.
- 2. RRSA- It was agreed that we all needed to work on our understanding of the convention, what our rights were, and how we could respect our own rights and those of other people. (School council emphasised that this was everyone in school, not just children.)

The main articles for further work were;

Article 28 - the right to an education

Article 29 - developing personality and talents, encouraging respect for human rights, as well as respect for their parents, each other, their own and other cultures, and the environment. Article 42 - make sure children and adults know about the Convention.

All classes to be involved in discussion work, learning activities, circle time to develop understanding of articles 28, 29 and 42. Staff meeting time to discuss the articles.
