Hope everyone has had a lovely summer holidays, weren't we lucky with the weather! The EYFS team welcome all the new families that are starting with us this term and welcome back all the families we have been fortunate to have worked with last year or in the past.

We have an open door policy, please see Mrs Byrne if you have any questions, concerns or suggestions; we are always happy to listen!

Please make sure all uniform is **named!** Staff do their very best to try and ensure all uniform is sent home, however there are 90 children each day accessing the unit, returning uniform that is not named is impossible! Thanks for your understanding.

We are due more hot weather this month, please ensure that your child comes to the unit dressed in appropriate clothing and footwear. Sun hats and cream if appropriate. Open toe shoes are not allowed for health and safety reasons.

We will continue to promote Oral Health in the unit. All children that have consent will be encouraged to brush their teeth daily. To support this, we ask for a £2 donation for every child to help cover some of the cost of tooth brushes and tooth paste.

Please can I stress the importance of ensuring your child is brought to nursery / school on time every day. Crucial phonic activities happen every morning and being late results in your child missing out. Also, a polite reminder that parents / carers collect their children on time at the end of the session / day.

Please can I remind all parents / carers who have children not yet toilet trained, it is your responsibility to send nappies and wipes into nursery every day in a named bag.

Children are **not** allowed to wear bracelets and necklaces. If they have their ears pierced, they must be studs. We are not able to take these out or cover them for your child during physical activities and in EYFS this happens daily. We do not take any responsibility for accidents caused by wearing jewellery or of any jewellery is lost. Sorry for any inconvenience.

Please can I remind parents / carers, we ask for 50p donation each week to help us support the cost of snack / baking / etc.

Please can you make sure that your child has a spare pair of pants and socks in their school bag. Even if your child does not have an accident this is still recommended just in case.
