OPAL Award: On Tuesday, Mrs Byrne and myself were involved in a 3 hour OPAL assessment which was extremely thorough. This was to ascertain how well the school are doing on their OPAL journey, which has been in place now for 13 months. We were delighted to be awarded the highest possible level of certificate, which is Platinum! Only 10% of OPAL schools in the country have are judged as Platinum and none in Bishop Auckland so this is an amazing achievement and well-deserved. My special thanks go to the Lunchtime Supervisory staff, without whom we would not be able to provide such a rich and varied OPAL offer. Massive thanks also to Mrs Byrne who had led the programme and the OPAL working group (Mrs Oldfield, Mr Walker and Miss Blenkinsopp) for their enthusiasm in driving it forward across the whole school. Finally, to you, the parents and carers, who are so fabulous at providing equipment for the children to use in OPAL. We really do appreciate it! Well done to everyone!

<u>Mud!</u> ...and on the subject of fabulous play provision, one of the areas we have as part of OPAL is the Mud Kitchen.
