Behaviour system Look at class responses to questions we set out.	<p><u>Step tracker</u> - Year 1 and 2 now have bronze, silver and gold stars for positive behaviour. Years 3 – 6 now have bronze, silver and gold medals for positive behaviour. It was felt that the step tracker works for some children but not all. There was some discussion about how it is the same children on the step tracker every day.</p> <p><u>Think sheets</u> - Year 1, 3, 4, 5, and 6 use them. Year 2 does not use them in class and in partner classes. Not all classes felt that they worked.</p> <p><u>Rewards</u> – all classes have a good selection of rewards when children get onto the stars or medals and for good work. Dojos, dip in the box, good book for work, certificates, extra play time, pupil of the day, star of the week.</p> <p><u>Restart</u>- not all children feel that restart works as it is the same children using it and they are not changing their behaviour. There were lots of suggestions for a new name; Reset, Fresh Start, Thinking Time, Re-Isolation, Silent Room, Reflection, Calm Room, Thinking Room, Time-Out, Quiet Room.</p>	<p><u>Questions that arose</u> Can children move up and down the step tracker across the day? Is each new day a new start for each child?</p> <p>If they are not working what should we use?</p> <p>If it is the same children using it does it work? Should these children have something else?</p>
